## **Team Cross-check at Referring Hospital**





Is the ETT secure?

What is the most recent blood gas? (Read gas aloud) Has the CXR been reviewed? (If applicable)

Is the current ventilation satisfactory?

Is the BP stable?

Does the patient need a fluid bolus/inotropes?

Is the temperature stable?





Is the patient adequately sedated/paralysed?

Are the Glucose/Electrolytes stable?

Is there an NGT in place?

Has the patient adequate working vascular access?

What is the position of the lines and are they secure?

What Drugs need to be drawn up before departure?



- Self inflating bag and mask
- Resus drugs
- Suction catheters
- Intubation set



- Transport flowsheets/Referral History form/ Consent form
- Copy of the initial Cooling Graph (If applicable)
- Letters/Bloods/X-ray/Scans
- Patient ID Bands x 2

Is the suction working?

Is there adequate power supply for the journey?

Is there adequate O<sub>2</sub>/Air supply for the journey?

What is the aim of the transfer?

What is the biggest risk to the patient in transit?

-How can we prepare for this?

Time to call the Receiving Unit and begin the transfer
